



2006 Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2006 Barlow Estate Cabernet Sauvignon has tremendous richness because of the fruit's ripeness, and a solid tannin structure that will allow it to mature nicely over time. Dark and decadent, but with a good showing of balance and complexity makes this wine accessible now but can also be cellared for years to come. The aroma captures the property with its classic black sour cherry and a hint of sweet French oak.

The 2006 wonderfully long growing season presented magnificent hang time for the fruit to develop complex, concentrated flavors highlighting 2006 as a very vibrant year. Tight tannins lend the notion that wines from 2006 should be long-lived. The cool growing season held high acids, which are coming into balance.
